It's a risky business this wine game. It requires knowledge, experience, passion and a big leap of faith to take the grape to bottle and win a few hearts along the way. Grapegrower for two decades, Rob Quenby has seen it all, grown it all and now it's his turn to show what great vineyards and some risky business can do.

Displays intense ripe berry aromas with underlying dusty and earthy characters. Palate shows intense and fully ripe fleshy sweet fruit filling the mid-palate with smooth tannins.

Colour: Dense dark red to black colour of great intensity.

Aroma: A rich bouquet with ripe cassis and berry fruits, rich and opulent.

Palate: This wine has ample flavour and concentration in the classic Margaret River style. Intense fleshy and full mid-palate with huge fruit weight with dark cherry and blackcurrant flavours. Fruit sweetness will become more apparent with bottle age.

Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon 100%

This wine is produced from selected low intervention vineyards, then hand-made by using small batch winemaking techniques.
