Grapegrower for two decades, Rob Quenby has seen it all, grown it all and now it's his turn to show what great vineyards and some risky business can do.

Vermentino, traditionally grown in southern Italy has a new home in Mount Barker, deep in the south west of Western Australia. The fine and cool climate conditions produce a wine light and bright with clean citrus and delicate tropical fruits. Deliciously fresh.

Colour: Clear and bright with the barest hint of colour.

Aroma: Fresh and vibrant tropical fruit aromas; for example fresh pineapple and pear. Attractive 'sherbet' aromas.

Palate: A beautiful palate; quite delicate but still with very good mouthfeel. Delicate pear and 'fruit salad' flavours with a gentle, clean acidity; very good persistence of flavour. A delicious wine to enjoy as an aperitif or serve with a wide variety of foods. Best enjoyed as a young wine.
